Summary of Lesson Resources

- 2 Create MIDI file: Use music notation software like Sibelius, Finale, Dorico to create the MIDI file. The reason to avoid real-time input of MIDI is to ensure that the music notes are of the correct length. It takes a lot of time to clean up the notation.
- Input MIDI file into MIDI visualizer: Import the MIDI file into a MIDI visualizer like Synthesia.
- Screen record the MIDI visualizer: Get a good screen recorder like Bandicam and screen record the song that is imported into the MIDI visualizer.
- ② **(Optional) Record live piano performance**: You might want to add real-time piano playing below the MIDI visualizer. You can do so by recording your piano playing by playing along with the MIDI.
- ② **(Optional) Edit videos**: After recording your piano performance, you will have to edit the screen recording and the piano performance into one video by using video editors like Filmora.
